








Visited with local guides, tour proceeds support a community non-profit. Shared candies with kids and witnessed pure joy in Kibera slum.


Danced, learned beadwork, and connected with the Maasai people. A true cultural immersion that supports sustainable tourism.

SN	Requirements	Status	Notes
1	Valid Passport	Required	Must be valid for at least 6 months beyond your arrival date.
2	Photo	Required	Clear solo photo with white background (JPEG format)
3	Flight Ticket Reservation	Optional	I booked a confirmed round-trip ticket.
4	Hotel Reservation	Required	I used Booking.com with no prepayment required.



Application Steps

1. Visit <https://etakenya.go.ke>
2. Fill out the form – It took me only 10 minutes to complete the application.
3. Upload documents – Passport scan, photo, flight and hotel details.
4. Pay the fee – USD 32.50 via credit/debit card.
5. Receive your eTA – I got mine in just 10 minutes via email!

The Kenya eTA issued to me is valid for 72 days, from October 1 to December 12, 2025, and allows single entry.
